

Ancestors of Christina Buchanan



Generation No. 1

1. Christina Buchanan¹, born Abt. 1863 in PEI; died 15 Feb 1926 in Rutland State Sanitorium, Rutland, Middlesex Co, Massachusetts. She was the daughter of **2. John Buchanan** and **3. Isabella MacIntosh**. She married **(1) Frederick Green** 01 Aug 1893 in Boston, Suffolk Co, Massachusetts. He was born 01 May 1868 in Hounslow, Middlesex, England², and died 15 Nov 1955 in Boston, Suffolk Co, Massachusetts³. He was the son of Thomas Green and MaryAnn Scott.

Notes for Christina Buchanan:

Christina's date of birth calculated from her age reported at the time of her death, would be 1866. If the year of 1866 is correct, she would have been born just before her mother, Isabella, married Donald MacPhee.

Christy was shown as being age 18 in the 1881 Canadian census - giving her an approximate year of birth of 1863, which appears to be more correct and there were only 2 years between Christy and her brother Anthony.

There is much information on Christina and Frederick's family in various family files submitted to Ancestry.com, but most notably by Christine Conlon. The information is therefore unconfirmed, although she has provided detailed source information which appears to be accurate and some of which has been confirmed through census, death records, etc.

Note - Christina's surname has been spelled phonetically as 'Bohannon' in all the Ancestry family records.

1900 US Census - Chelsea Ward 1, Suffolk Co, Massachusetts

Christina (31) and Frederick (31) are residing at 73 Essex Street with their daughters Sadie M (2) and Marion F (1). They have been married for 7 years and Christina is the mother of 2 children, both of whom are living.

Frederick is a carriage blacksmith and states he immigrated in 1872. Christina immigrated in 1885.

Note - Christina's date of birth was recorded as Feb 1869, which is incorrect given the date of her mother's 2nd marriage.

1910 US Census - Medford Ward 5, Middlesex Co, Massachusetts

Christina (43) and Frederick (41) are now residing at 49 Granville Avenue with their children Sadie M (12), Marion F (10), Alfred B (9) and Florence I (5).

Christina and Frederick have been married for 17 years and Christina is the mother of 6 children, 4 of whom are still living. She states she immigrated in 1895. Frederick is a blacksmith at a carriage company.

1920 US Census - Medford Ward 5, Middlesex Co, Massachusetts

Christina (54) and Fred (50) are still residing at 49 Granville Avenue with Marion (20) and Alfred (19). Christina and Fred both indicate they immigrated in 1887. Fred is a blacksmith in a machine shop and Marion is working as a ?computator operator for a bank.

Daughter Florence is not listed.

From Helen J. Hilton, details from Christy's Death record (Massachusetts Vital Records, 1926 Deaths, Vol. 52, page 377).

"Christena Green of 49 Granville Avenue, Medford, Mass., died at Rutland State Sanatorium, Rutland, Mass., on 15 February 1926 at 2:30 a.m., aged 59 years, 11 months, 24 days.

Married; wife of Frederick Green.

In city or town where death occurred: 7 months, 16 days.

Occupation: Practical nurse.

Cause of death: Pulmonary tuberculoses, 30 years. No autopsy.

Born P.E.I.

Father: John Buchanna [typo on record], born Scotland.

Mother: Isabel McIntosh, born P.E.I.
Buried Oak Grove Cemetery, Medford, Mass., 17 February 1926. Geo. Sessions Sons Co., Worcester, Mass., undertakers.
Informant: State Sanatorium Records, Rutland.
Reported from Medford, Mass."

Notes for Frederick Green:

1871 British Census - Parish of Isleworth, Middlesex, England
Frederick (3) is found residing with his parents Thomas and Mary Ann Green (both 27). His place of birth is recorded as Hounslow, Middlesex, England.

1930 US Census - Medford, Middlesex Co, Massachusetts
A widowed Fred (60) is now residing at 51 Granville Avenue with his daughter Sadie M Kissick (32) and her husband Edward G Kissick (36) and their children Christine F (9) and Alfred E (5). Sadie was age 22 when she married. Fred is now listed as a helper blacksmith.

2. John Buchanan, born Bet. 1834 - 1836 in Loch Lomond Area of Scotland; died Bef. 05 Jan 1866 in probably Colville Road, PEI^{4,5}. He married **3. Isabella MacIntosh** 26 Aug 1852 in PEI^{6,7}.

3. Isabella MacIntosh⁷, born May 1833 in PEI^{8,9}; died 04 Jan 1906 in Elmwood, PEI¹⁰. She was the daughter of **6. Roderick MacIntosh** and **7. Euphemia MacPherson**.

Notes for John Buchanan:

From Helen Hilton, a descendant of John's son Anthony Buchanan:

John came from Loch Lomond, Scotland (unknown date of arrival or age). John apparently came to PEI alone as a young man and his family remained in Scotland. He was killed at the age of 29 by a horse on his farm (date unknown) and was reportedly buried in a grave behind his farm.

Since Loch Lomond is surrounded by the counties of Dunbartonshire, Stirlingshire and Argyleshire and there are numerous John Buchanan's to be found born in this time period, he would probably have been in the 1841 Scottish census, but since his exact location is unknown, he and his remaining family are impossible to trace back any further in time.

If daughter Christina's year of birth is correct, John would have presumably died sometime in 1865, since Isabella remarried on Jan. 5, 1866. Based on his supposed age of 29 at his death, he would have been born 1835/1836. John and Isabella married in 1852, so, based on these dates, it appears John would have been quite young (about 17) when he and Isabella married, which doesn't seem possible.
The mystery of John continues!

Notes for Isabella MacIntosh:

No birth record or death record has been found for Isabella to prove her parentage. However, oral family history (source: Isabelle MacPhee) maintains that Donald MacPhee and his brother married two sisters. I have assumed, until any evidence to the contrary is found, that Isabella MacIntosh is the sister of Donald's brother John MacPhee's wife, Flora MacIntosh and that her parents are therefore also Roderick MacIntosh and Euphemia MacPherson.

On 1891 Census, Isabella states that both parents were born in Scotland (as were Roderick MacIntosh and Euphemia MacPherson, according to Death Record of Flora MacIntosh).

Isabella was a widow with 6 children in 1866 when she married Donald MacPhee, who was about 12 years her junior.

THERE departed this life at her home Elmwood on Thursday, the 4th inst. Isabelle McIntosh, beloved wife of Donald McPhee in the 74th year of her age. Deceased was born at Springton, Lot 67, P.E.I. She was twice married, her first husband being John Buchannan [sic], Colville Road, by whom she had two sons and four daughters namely, Malcolm and Athony [sic], Elmwood; Mrs. Frederick Green, Chelsea, Mass [sic]; Euphemia in Newton Centre; the late Mrs. John McKinnon, Charlottetown, and Mrs. John Russ, Charleston [sic]. By the second marriage there were four sons and two daughters, John in Quincy, Mass; James, Rhode Island; Daniel in Boston; Mrs. Chas E. McDonald, Churchill, P.E.I.; Mrs B.F. McDuff, R.I [sic]; and William at home with whom deceased resided. There are also twenty-seven grandchildren and two great grand children [sic]. In early life she was brought to a knowledge of the truth and became a member of the Presbyterian Church. She was visited during her illness by Revs. Mr. McIntosh and Mr. Harrison as well as elders etc. of the church with al [sic] of whom she loved to converse respecting eternity. She bore her illness which was cancer of the stomach without a murmer [sic] and died trusting in the finished work of her Lord and Saviour. The funeral took place on Friday the 5th, to Clyde River Cemetery and was largely attended. The pallbearers were H. McMillan, Neil McKinnon, Andrew McElroy, James Wynne, John Curley, Nicholas Colwill.

Sarah (25) is married to John (35) and they are residing with their daughters Minnie (3) and Annie (5). All are of Scottish descent, were born in PEI and are Presbyterian in religion.

1891 Canadian Census - Charlottetown, PEI

Sarah (37) and John (45) are now residing in Charlottetown with children Annie (15), Minnie (13), Harry (8) and Ella (5).

A Sarah was found in the cemetery transcript for Clyde River Cemetery. I am assuming she is a daughter of John Buchanan and Isabella MacIntosh because:

1. She is buried in the plot beside Isabella MacIntosh
2. Her date of birth, 1853, would fit in between the marriage date and the birth of the first child of John and Isabella
3. In the 1901 Census, there is a Harry A. McKinnon, age 18, living with Anthony Buchanan, who is stated to be a nephew. This fits with Sarah having died in 1893.
4. Also in the 1901 Census, there is a Mary McKinnon, age 9, 'ad daughter', living with Isabella MacIntosh and Donald MacPhee. This also fits with Sarah having died in 1893.

Notes for Euphemia Buchanan:

Never married.

1900 US Census - Boston Ward 24, Suffolk Co, Massachusetts

A single 'Euphemia Bohannan' (39) is working as a servant in the household of George and Mary Frost at 2 Frost Avenue in Boston. She was born December 1860 in PEI, her father was born in Scotland and her mother in PEI.

Date of birth is inconsistent with her supposed age at death and her tombstone, but this is the same Euphemia.

1910 US Census - Newton Ward 6, Middlesex Co, Massachusetts

'Euphemia Bohanan' (49) is now a servant in the household of George and Mabel West at 860 Beacon Street in Newton. She immigrated in 1884, her father was born in Scotland and her mother in Canada.

Euphemia was not located in 1920. She presumably returned home to PEI before then.

Tombstone for Euphemia and brother Malcolm shows both born in 1856. However 1881 Census shows Euphemia age 23, 2 years younger than Malcolm, age 25. Obituary for Euphemia says that she was in her 91st year when she died in 1947.

iv. Mary Buchanan²⁴, born Abt. 1860 in PEI^{25,26}; died Unknown; married John Russ Aft. 1881; born Abt. 1866 in New Brunswick²⁷; died Unknown.

Notes for Mary Buchanan:

Mary is listed as being 'Mrs John Russ, Charleston' in her mother's obituary in 1906.

Address is presumed to be Charlestown (Boston), Middlesex Co, Massachusetts, but the family could not be located in any census records.

I have found no record of Mary or John and nothing on daughter Bessie who presumably married a Troff Abbott. I'm presuming 'Troff' is a nickname as nothing can be located for him.

Notes for John Russ:

1881 Canadian Census - Charlottetown Royalty, Queens Co, PEI

A John H Russ (15) is residing in Charlottetown with the family of Donald and Elizabeth McKinnon. He was born c1866 in New Brunswick and is Wesleyan Methodist in religion.

John is the only 'Russ' found in the 1881 census who is residing in PEI.

It's probable therefore that this is Mary's husband, even though he is slightly younger than her.

Anthony's brother Malcolm (45) and a nephew Harry McKinnon (18), born 26 December 1883, are also present.

1911 Canadian Census - Elmwood, Part Lot 31 & 65, Queens's Co, PEI

Anthony (49) and Jane (46) are residing with John (20), Fred (18), Sarah A (17), William (14), Minnie (12), Roland (10), 'Phebe' (8), 'Margaret' (7) and Hazel (6).

According to National Archives Post Office data base (archives.ca), Anthony Buchanan was Postmaster at Elmwood P.O. from its opening Sep. 1 1895 til its closing Dec. 6 1913.

There passed away at Churchill on Wed, July 31st, 1938, Mrs. Anthony Buchanan at the age 73 years.

Hampshire, Mrs Robert MacKinnon (Hazel), Churchill, John of Bonshaw, Fred of Churchill, William of Regina, Sask and Roland at home.

The pall bearers were John Allan MacKinnon, Neil MacKinnon, Jack Colwill, Alex Doherty, John Gallant and Clement Wynne.

The Last Will and Testament of Roderick MacIntosh (-1875, Springton, Lot 67)

PEI Archives RG 6.2 Series 1 Wills Vol. 8 p. 884-885

In the name of God I Roderick MacIntosh of Springton Township number sixty seven in PEI Farmer do make and ordain this my last will and Testament.

I give devise and bequeath to Donald my son fifty acres of land being the eastern half of my farm and adjoining land now in possession of Alexander Stuart.

I give devise and bequeath to John MacPhee the husband of my daughter Flora the remaining half of my farm containing fifty acres and bounded on the west side by land in possession of Donald MacLeod together with all the residue of my property with the exceptions herein contained. I also give to the said John MacPhee the right to occupy the dwelling house in which I now reside to be his own and also the site thereof while the house shall last after which time it shall be left to Donald my Son as part of his aforesaid fifty acres.

I also direct that Euphemia my wife shall be comfortably supported by the said John MacPhee during the whole of her natural life so long as she may choose to remain with him but in the event of her leaving him he shall give her in lieu of said support two cows and six sheep.

I give and bequeath the sum of twenty five cents to each of the rest of my children. And I appoint my brother Donald MacIntosh as my Executor of this my last Will and Testament. And I hereby declare this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy five.

Angus and son Angus are farming and Donald indicates his occupation as seafaring.

**A single 'Frank Massengill (22), born in PEI is found residing in Lowell, Cochise Co, Arizona in June 1918 when he signed his draft registration card. His date of birth is given as April 21, 1896.

Also, the semi-weekly 'Adviser' of Charlottetown contained obit for Christie, relict of the late Lodevick M'Intosh, 90 years of age. (The foregoing courtesy of Bonnie Swingle).

Note: If Christy died in 1863 at age 99, her birth year would be c1764, approximately 18 years prior to Lodevick, and her last child would have been born when she was 50, both unlikely. If she died at age 90 in 1863, she would be 9 years older than Lodevick, which is possible.

Is Christy buried with Lodevick at Springton? Her name is not on any tombstone there.
Could Christy possibly be living with son Donald at the 1861 Census??
